
Capacity Building of the Environmental Conservation Department (ECD-CAB)

T he project has entered its third year, and at present the following activities are given priority:

- The development of pig farming licensing rules and pollution control regulations
- Monitoring of Mammut Copper Mine and Likas River Pollution Sources
- Review of the Enactment (CEE)
- The Indicator Report, and in relation to this; planning and initiation of a number of surveys, including waste water treatment plants, landfills, EIA compliance, Public Environmental Opinion
- Finalisation of Forestry and Oil Palm guideline
- Initiation of the Aquaculture EIA guideline
- Continuous implementation of MIS and GIS
- Development of awareness materials
- Targeted technical training, e.g. in EIA assessment, water quality, map use and slopes assessment

Below are highlighted some of the ongoing ECD-CAB activities for each of the divisions in the ECD. Also included is a list of technical reports, background papers and awareness materials prepared until now. Many of these reports are available from the homepage: www.sabah.gov.my/jkas/programmes.

Environmental Planning

Preparations for the environmental indicator report has continued. The report will cover rural and urban rivers, mangrove cover, coral reefs, flora & fauna. Number of other activities have been linked to the preparation of the Indicator Report, such as public opinion survey, Likas River Survey, wastewater treatment survey, mangrove mapping, natural resource mapping in cooperation with Land & Survey Department.

The review of the Conservation of Environment Enactment has been initiated and a local consultant been contracted.

Environmental Impact Assessment (EIA)

The preparation of the guideline for aquaculture has been initiated in collaboration with Fisheries Department.

Guidelines for river sand and stone mining, construction on hill slopes, forest activities and oil palm plantations have been finalised. An inter-department meeting with Forestry Department has been held.

An EIA compliance survey has been initiated.

Monitoring and Enforcement

The environmental investigation, administrative enforcement and prosecution manual has been finalised and distributed. A draft livestock licensing rules and pollution control of pig farming regulation has been drafted and is presently being discussed with the Veterinary Department. The survey of all pig farms in Sabah has been finalised.

A monitoring program for potential pollution and mitigation measures for Mammut Copper Mine has been initiated in cooperation with UMS.

Communication & Awareness

ECD presentation folder, pamphlet and poster and an ECD-CAB pamphlet have been produced and distributed.

The production of an Environmental Video has been finalised and will be distributed soon.

Environmental Information Systems (EIS)

T he first version of the MIS component is presently being pilot-tested within the EIA section of the Department.

Following the provided GIS training, the GIS section has produced a number of maps, e.g. for the Love the Moyog River Campaign, a undertaken analysis of satellite images from 1991 and 2000 in relation to mangrove, protected area protection, etc. These analyses will be used for the Environmental Indicator report.

Administration

The ISO documentation materials has been finalised and certification was received in September.
