Abbreviations	Definitions
YS	Yayasan Sabah or Sabah Foundation was established in 1966 by an enactment of the Sabah Legislative Assembly. YS has entered into a “Sustainable Forest Management Licence Agreement” (SFMLA) with the Sabah State Government on Sept. 10, 1997 covering an area of 599,828 ha. The said area is also generally known as “YS Concession Area”.
ICSB	Innoprise Corporation Sdn Bhd was incorporated in 1988 as the investment vehicle of YS as well as the management and holding company of the YS’s group of companies.
SSB	Sabah Softwoods Bhd, a subsidiary of ICSB
BWSB	Benta Wawasan Sdn Bhd, a wholly owned subsidiary of ICSB and it has entered into a “Tree Plantation and Forest Management Agreement” (TPFMA) with the Chief Minister of Sabah on 24 April 1996, and a Supplemental Agreement on February 15, 1999. The total area under the said licence agreement is about 306,310 ha.
OPP Project	The proposed development of oil palm plantation in the Project Area.
ITP Project	The proposed development of industrial tree plantation project in the Project Area, focusing on area between 20 to 25 degrees in slope. However, this plan will be carried out only at a much later stage.
INIKEA	A forestry project on rehabilitation of degraded forest between Innoprise Corporation Sdn Bhd (ICSB) and the Sow-a-Seed foundation established by the IKEA group of Sweden.
LFC	Luasong Forestry Centre is a center for tropical forest management and development of RBJ.
