Chapter 2

General Information

2.1 General

This Chapter introduces the proposed Project, the Project Proponent, the SEIA consultants and the public hearing processing under the SEIA guidelines in Sabah.

2.2 The Proposed Project

The proposed Project is titled "The Proposed Oil Palm Plantation (OPP) and Industrial Tree Plantation (ITP) Development at Benta Wawasan I and Benta Wawasan IIC, Yayasan Sabah Forest Management Area, Kalabakan and Gunung Rara Forest Reserves, Tawau District, Sabah". For brevity in this SEIA report, the proposed Project will be referred to as the "Proposed Plantation", the "Proposed Oil Palm and Tree Plantation" or simply, the "OPP and ITP development".

The proposed Oil Palm and Tree Plantation Project area is about 109,600 ha and is made up of the Benta Wawasan Licence Area^{2a} I and IIC (see **Figure 2.2.1**). Out of this total area, approximately 80,000 ha are expected to be planted with oil palm. The rest will either be tree plantation or non-operable areas. For information, the ITP development has already been covered in an SEIA^{2b} submitted and subsequently approved by the Environmental Protection Department Sabah in April 2003. Most of the team members selected to conduct the assessments for this SEIA are also those who have previously conducted extensive studies at the Project area.

Other environmental reports related to the proposed Project area include an Environmental Impact Statement (EIS) for the timber harvesting operations in Benta Wawasan Licence Area (1998-1999) and an Environmental Impact Assessment (EIA) for the timber harvesting operations in Benta Wawasan Licence Area (2000-2001). Both of these have been submitted to the Environment Protection Department (EPD), Sabah in February and June 2001, respectively for approval (see **Figure 2.2.2** for location of logging coupes). Compliance monitoring of the logging operation is being

It has entered a "Tree Plantation and Forest Management Agreement" (TPFMA) with the Chief Minister of Sabah on 24 April 1996, and a Supplemental Agreement on February 15, 1999. 2.5 Public hearings

As this report is a Special-EIA, it needs to comply with the Environment Protection Department (EPD) Sabah's requirement for public hearing procedures is a two-stage opportunity to enable the public to provide inputs and comments for this SEIA.

 Stage 1- TOR for Special EIA - Suggestions as to the issues the Special-EIA should consider, thus ensuring that the TOR for the Special-EIA address the main issues and concerns.

The draft TOR for this SEIA was announced on the 18th and 19th February 2005 in the Daily Express, Sabah, New Sabah Times and the EPD homepage (http://www.sabah.gov.my/jpas) providing an opportunity for the public to comment on the forthcoming SEIA. The public was given a period of 14 days (from 21st February to 9th March 2005) to give his/her written comments to the EPD either by mail or via the EPD homepage. The consultants are required to provide a written reply or response to those comments and details of the comments are attached in **Annex D** at the end of this report.

 Stage 2 - Assessment of Special EIA reports. Comments on the validity and relevance of the assessments and proposed mitigation and monitoring measures.

As for this Stage of the public hearing, a one-month period is given to the public for the assessment of the reports. The hearings will be announced in the local newspapers. The TOR and the Special-EIA reports will be made available from the Project Proponent, the EPD office and homepage of EPD (http://www.sabah.gov.my/jpas). Comments from the public shall be sent to EPD and the EIA consultant will provide a written reply to the comments. Replies will be made available at the EPD office and homepage. The EPD will take into consideration the comments and the replies and will include relevant public concerns in the TOR or in the Agreement of Environmental Conditions.
